
Jagdish Lal Ahuja

- Born in **Peshawar** in Pakistan, **partition** had forced him into becoming the sole breadwinner of the family at a young age looks for his own lost childhood through the eyes of the children he feeds

- Reduced STD rates by making HIV tests mandatory before marriages
- Prepared 5-year action plans for ecological conservation
- Built 40,000 trenches around hills to conserve rainwater
- Planted 4.5 lakh trees



Voice of Bhopal

- Convener of Bhopal Gas Peedit Mahila
 Udyog Sangathan, an advocacy group for victims, survivors & their families
- His 35-year-long struggle from a hand pump fitter to a people's advocate is reference point in independent India's history of people's movements
- Provided vocational training to 2,300 widows of those who died from the gas leak
- Filed petitions in court seeking medical rehabilitation for victims
- Gas leak from the Union Carbide plant in Bhopal had killed more than 3,500 people
- Lost his family after the gas leak, while he suffered lung fibrosis and lost 50% of his vision due to the accident
- **Posthumous** (15 Nov 2019)



- Established seed bank successfully preserving hundreds of varieties of various crops in a traditional tribal way
- Created methods to harvest water on farms thereby turning wasteland into fertile land
- Increased crop yield by 30% with improved cultivation practices
- Excellent outreach work, training other farmers and spread awareness

- Veteran exponent of Shadow puppetry, an ancient art form of storytelling using flat cutout leather figures as puppets
- Narrations are on mythological themes like the Mahabharata & Ramayana
- Performed over 60 shows **internationally**
- Inspired & trained youth in the art form
- Preserving a dying art, as poverty turns these puppet artistes into farmhands
- Despite being old & frail, continues to be the patriarch of **Nimmalakunta** village in Anantpur district synonymous with the art form

- Maiti derived from Mait, meaning married woman's parental home, began with encouraging tree plantation on a girl's wedding
- Started in 1995, Maiti movement has spread across 6,000 villages in 18 states & 5 countries (UK, Canada, Indonesia, Nepal & Bhutan) in past 25 years
- It is one of India's biggest afforestation movements
- Founder President Himalayan Vanya Jeev Sansthan
- Created 'Shaurya Van' in memory of Kargil martyrs
- Also campaigned against animal sacrifice and providing education to the girl-child
- Retired **Teacher**, Government Inter College


