"Internationally acclaimed **Bhil Painter** from Jhabhua - First to transfer mud wall paintings to huge canvasses"




- 1st Bhil Artist to use paper and canvas for traditional Pithora paintings which have traditionally been done on mud walls
- Began painting from a young age, bringing
 Bhil life and culture to life since 40 years –
 from myths about triumphant goddesses to everyday village life filled with songs, rituals, tattoos and folklore
- Used neem twigs as brushes and extracted natural colors from plants, soil and clays
- Took up painting despite being from a community where women are not allowed to pick a paintbrush - encouraging other women to take up painting as well
- Through diligence and devotion she rose to prominence with her artwork being exhibited and sold globally

SHANTI DEVI

Shanti aur Seva ki Devi





- 86 yr old Gandhian from Gunupur village who founded Seva Samaj Ashram for rehabilitating orphan, destitute and poor children
- The Ashram which started with 8 tribals, has now transformed into a hub of education and welfare of 131 such children
- Imbibed with ideologies of Mahatma
 Gandhi and Vinoba Bhave, worked to wipe out a skin disease called Yaws and cured over 4,000 infected
- Participated in the Bhoodan Sarvodaya
 Movement led by Vinobha Bhave in 1951
- With a focus on empowering women, she provided vocational training to 200 destitute women of Adivasi and weaker sections in tailoring, knitting, spices making, etc

Chitrakathi ki Aatma Ganga



"Folk Artist from Sindhudurg - famous for preserving 500 year old art of Chitrakathi storytelling"

- Narrates the stories of Ramayana and
 Mahabharata through paintings and folk
 songs
- Till date, he continues to use natural colours made from soil, flowers, vegetables and leaves
- Established 'Thakar Adivasi Kala Aangan' museum and art gallery to showcase the Thakar tribal folk arts of Sindhudurg
- Has trained more than 100 students to keep the dying art form alive
- Contemporized Chitrakathi beyond mythological stories, by painting to raise awareness about current situation and educate people about cleanliness, Covid-19 and social distancing

MANJAMMA JOGATI

Yellamma ki Jogati

"Transgender Folk Dancer of Jogamma heritage - 1st transwoman President of Karnataka Janapada Academy"



- Jogati Nritya Folk Dancer who has performed 1,000 times in the past 35 years
- Became the 1st transwoman President of Karnataka Janapada Academy in 2019
- Found a reason to live through dance after being stuck in a life of destitution, social stigmas and resistance
- Her story of resilience is now a part of syllabus for Bachelor in Arts course at Karnataka Folk University in Haveri
- Jogati Nritya is a ritual folk dance performed by a group of women - generally Jogappas, a community of transgender people in north Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and Maharashtra, to appease Goddess Yellamma

GHULAM RASOOL KHAN

Kashmiri Kaarigari ke Khan

"Jamawar Patchwork Artist from Srinagar - conserving the oldest form of Kashmiri shawl technique"



- Jamawar considered to be the oldest form of Kashmiri shawl technique, which is being practiced by artisans for more than 700 yrs
- Developed new form of Jamawar shawl by creating the first Shawl with 64 pieces as opposed to conventional 32 pieces
- Crafted new prints of Sozni embroidery, the traditional style of Kashmiri embroidery
- As Director of B K Handicrafts has provided employment to over 300 artisans
- Winner of National Award for Textile (2006)
 + Shilp Guru Award (2010)

CHUTNI DEVI

Seraikela ki Sherni

"Tribal activist from Seraikela famous as 'Tigress' - for having single-handedly saved 60 women from Witch-hunting"



- 62 yr old brave-heart popular as 'Tigress' in her locality for strongly opposing the social evil of Witch-hunting - tirelessly fighting the evil practice for decades
- From being branded a 'Dayan' herself, she faced and overcame strong opposition and even violent attacks with undeterred willpower, and has till date successfully rescued more than 60 women
- She also served as an example for humanity, by providing food to the underprivileged on her own with no support from local authorities
- It is estimated that more than 1,500 women have been killed because of being branded as witches over the past 2 decades

RAMCHANDRA MANJHI

Bhojpuri Naach Nayak

"95 yr old Naach Folk dancer from Bihar- carrying forward the legacy of grameennatak for over 8 decades"



- Dedicated his life to keep the tradition of Naach alive, a prominent Bhojpuri folk art form where men impersonate women in performances - comprising of songs, dance, comedy, satire, pun, banter, parody and theatre
- Plays are based on social evils and raise pertinent questions on caste discrimination, dowry killings etc
- Following his Guru (Bhikari Thakur)'s narrative art, passed from generation to generation since 11th century – continues to represent the dusty land of Bhojpur belt
- Even at the age of 95, his performances continue to be as astounding as ever

NANADRO B MARAK

Meghalaya's Black Pepper Marak

"Organic Farmer from West Garo hills growing black pepper - transferring his knowledge to others"




- A pioneering, progressive farmer, he produces 10,000 kgs of black pepper every year through complete organic farming techniques
- Black pepper is a crop which is very time consuming to grow
- Did not compromise on his farming methods despite hardships – the trees suffered damage during the initial years
- Apart from the 3,400 trees on his ancestral land, he planted 100 new saplings every year for over 3 decades
- To help farmers, he conducted training sessions which have benefitted 800 farmers across 18 villages

"Naga Folk Blues musician - known for resurrecting Manipur's Tangkhul Naga musical heritage"



- Modified Yangkahui, the traditional
 Tangkhul Naga flute to suit the western tone
- Created Naga tribal folk songs based on blues and ballad rhythms - 'Tantivy', 'Naga Folk Blues', 'Creation'
- Born in a remote village of Choithar in Ukhrul district, he is one of the most popular and ingenious Naga musicians
- Popularly known as 'King of Naga Folk Blues' and 'Cultural Ambassador of the Nagas'
- His latest song captures the emotions of people affected by Covid-19

SHYAM SUNDER PALIWAL

Piplantri's Super Sarpanch

"Inspirational **Sarpanch** of model village of **Piplantri** - catalysing pioneering work across forestry, water, **conservation** and **girl child** empowerment"



- As former Sarpanch of Piplantari village, successfully **transformed** his village with the **Piplantri Model now** recognized **internationally**
- Emulated by 157 panchayats in Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Bihar and other states
- Transformed village into lush green belt by planting 3.5 lakh trees through community engagement, which has improved water level by 10 times
- Initiated 'Kiran Nidhi Yojana' to celebrate every girl child's birth in the village by planting 111 saplings - dedicated himself towards the cause of the girl child, after the tragic death of his daughter
- Villagers now plant trees to commemorate births, deaths, and other major life events

- Loved by everyone, she is an inspiration to all on how age is never a barrier
- Eager to learn, she joined Tamil Nadu
 Agriculture Uni to receive formal training,
 and now is a part of its Advisory Committee
- Losing her parents at a young age, she was brought up by her paternal grandmother, who bequeathed a provision store for her
- Earnings from the provision store and an eatery she launched, helped her buy 10 acres of agricultural land - three-fourths of this she has given to her sister's daughters whom she brought up

Ganjam's ke Swasthya ke Krishna




"People's doctor from Ganjam known for serving the underprivileged - recognized for his pioneering work in Tribal healthcare"

- Born in Sukunda village, he earned his MS from England on scholarship, travelling over 22 countries, to ultimately quit his affluent life and return to India to fulfill his father's dream of serving the poor - continues to go strong even at 82 yrs
- Did pioneering work in **sickle cell** disease
- His innovative work on Tempramandibular Ankylosis led to a patient being able to eat for the first time in 20 years
- Still actively involved in research and education, presents papers internationally
- Established Bharadwaj Gurukul Ashram in maoist-affected backward region of Ganjam – a charitable organization providing free healthcare to tribals

GIRISH PRABHUNE

Pardhi ke Guru Girish

"Social Worker who has dedicated his life towards the empowerment of nomadic Pardhi tribals"



- Established **Punaruththan Samarasta Gurukulam**, school housing more than 300 students, mostly tribals
- Working particularly for upliftment of the Pardhi community, a denotified nomadic tribe criminalized under the British Raj
- He travels to remote places to request parents to send their children to Gurukul with a vision of bringing smiles to the faces of everyone attending his school
- Promotes traditional arts through Gurukul tradition
- Founder of Chapekar Memorial Museum transformed "Chapekar Wada" into a memorial, with photos of more than 450 revolutionaries

"100 yr old Village School Teacher from Jajpur - providing free education to generations since independence"




- Selfless, dedicated teacher with a mission to eradicate illiteracy, providing free education in Kantira village in Jajpur
- Keeping the tradition of chatashali alive (non-formal school, under a tree) - teaching multiple batches of students at dawn and elders at sunset without charging any fee for over 7 decades
- Many of his students have gone on to have successful careers
- Unfazed by health and financial issues, continues to **tirelessly serve** the society
- A people's person, respected and loved by all, is considered as a Head in resolving
 Panchayat issues

- Popular as "Gussadi Master", trained hundreds of Adivasi youth to keep the traditional dance form alive
- Led Gussadi cultural troupe to Delhi, performing at the 1981 Republic Day celebrations - promoting Unity in Diversity
- Performs wearing a Gussadi hair cap made of 1,500 peacock feathers locally known as Mal Boora
- From a very modest background, works as a cook on daily wages at a welfare hostel in Marlavai village

"Tribal **Hojagiri** dancer from Tripura - conserving & promoting **Reang tribe's** traditional dance for over 5 decades"




- Established Hojagiri Dance Academy and Lokaranjan Shakha for the propagation of indigenous art and dance forms of Tripura
- Started at an early age and imbibed the music and dance traditions of Reang tribe
- Gained proficiency in Hojagiri dances and Kokborok songs by performing in traditional festivals of the community
- Travelled widely across the country and globally
- Continues to strive to conserve and promote Hojagiri Dance by **training** young people of 'Reang' tribe - passing on his knowledge of the art form to the younger generation

"92 yr Physician from Bhagalpur - devoted to healthcare of **poor** for over **7 decades**"





- Practicing in remote Pirpainti town in Bhagalpur district since 1952 - when there was no electricity and roads, used horses to travel to different villages to offer treatment
- Treated and rehabilitated 250 Leprosy patients over a three decade period
- Amongst first to conduct free **Polio** vaccine camps in which thousands of children were vaccinated

"Para Freestyle Wrestler from Jhajjar - won India multiple medals on the world stage"




- Living through hearing and speech impairment, went on to not just represent India, but win her 7 medals in global events

- Continues to contribute as a Coach at Sports Authority of India
- Born in Jhajjar district's Sasroli village, trained under his father, a former wrestler woke up daily before dawn followed by 8 hr workouts, no vice and single-minded focus
- Inspired by him rising above circumstances, a National Award winning documentary film has been made on his life

- His illustrations helped bring to life various stories and **folklores** for **children**, while also persuading them to **think** and critically apply their minds
- Contributed to the field by making cartoons of both cultural connection and fiction
- His drawings incorporated vivid colours which made everything seem real
- Last artist of the original 'Chandamama' magazine's team from nineties

Sanitation Subbu

"Social Worker from Trichy who has impacted lakhs, especially **fishermen**, by installing 30 lakh eco-friendly, low-cost **toilets**"

- Established 'SCOPE', Society for Community Organisation and People's Education with the idea of promoting sanitation and rural development
- Introduced people to ECOSAN toilets, which are dry toilets with no flushes and septic tanks - suitable for areas with rocky terrain water scarcity
- A journey that started in 1986, evolved into installation of over 30 lakh units of environmentally sound toilets thereby impacting lives of 1.5 crore people
- The Ecosan toilet system is suitable for Manure produced through the toilets after 6 to 12 months of composting – this is distributed to the farmers free of cost, who earlier used to spend Rs 20,000 a year on manure and urea
