- Witnessed **illiterate women** getting turned away from the Bank where she worked, which **inspired** her to start her initiative
- Struggled for 8 years to turn idea into a reality – after numerous rejections, before several housewives came forward to buy shares with their hard earned money
- Starting with 1 branch in 2002, expanded to 4 branches handling 34,000 accounts aiming to open at least 1 branch in each of Assam's 33 districts
- Provided loans worth crores to thousands at low interest rate, with a high recovery rate
 70% of her customers are illiterate & 80% from deprived backgrounds

 - Set up his school, Sadai Fakirer Pathshala (*eternal fakir's school*) to make education accessible in an area where proper schooling facilities are unavailable
 - **80%** of his students are **girls** belonging to lower middle-class families
 - Led campaigns on socio-environmental issues and raised funds for thalassemia patients for five years in a row

Zanskar's Selfless Sevak




"Selfless hero who single handedly constructed 38-km road - connecting Ramjak to Kargyak village in remote Zanskar region of Kargil"

- Spent over Rs 50 lakhs from his own pocket after dipping into life savings and also selling his ancestral property
- Rented a JCB machine and 5 donkeys to build the road
- Constructing the road for over a decade at an average altitude of 11,500 feet also deteriorated his health

- His characters 'Bantul the Great', 'Nonte Fonte', 'Handa Bhonda,' are characters that have permeated down generations and have remained favourite among children even decades later
- A familiar name in all Bengal's households, children there have grown up reading his comics

- Having faced harsh challenges, she spreads awareness on issues like child marriage, AIDS, foeticide through her paintings
- Made **10,000 paintings**, displayed in over 50 exhibitions
- Trained more than 1,000 students through bodies like Mithila Art Institute and Seva Mithila Sansthan

Mamata ki Prakashini




"Social Worker from Jalandhar taking care of **abandoned girls** for 3 decades after being abandoned as a child"

- Apart from performing mythological stories of Ramayana and Puranas in over 40 temples, also performed shows describing Mahatma Gandhi's freedom struggle and raised awareness on topics like women empowerment, road safety etc

BIRUBALA RABHA



- Faced tremendous opposition including death threats through sheer will and courage – inspiring over 500 volunteers
- Instrumental in passing of Prevention and Protection from Witch Hunting Act, 2015, by the Government of Assam
- Dropped out of school after Class 5 and was married off early
- Witch-hunting is a form of superstition wherein women are blamed for unfortunate occurrences and targeted by fellow villagers, at times even being killed

- Working for over 6 decades, she has dressed 1,000 brides with her self-designed outfits
- Married off at the age of 15, she now creates awareness on issues like drug addiction and women employment
- Apart from designing Potloi, she also makes costumes for Khamba-Thoibi dances
- 'Potloi' is a skirt that forms an important part of the Manipuri wedding attire and comprises of stiff cylindrical skirt, blouse, woven belt around the waist, & 'Innaphi', which is a delicate muslin shawl wrapped around the upper body
